A Pilgrimage through Assisi & Rome with Fr. Richard Trezza

“Itinerary”

September 21:

Depart Boston late afternoon or early evening on your overnight flight to Rome.

September 22:

Arrival in **Rome** will be early to mid-morning. After clearing passport control you will be met by a Carrani Incoming Escort who will accompany you throughout your visit. Your escort will assist you to the deluxe motorcoach for your journey to **Assisi**. Upon arrival you will enjoy a 1/2 day city tour. (D)

September 23:

Today you will travel to **San Damiano**. The church and convent of **San Damiano** is where it all began in Assisi. This is the place where St. Francis first received his miraculous calling in 1205 and where St. Clare died in 1253, it is an important stop on the pilgrimage to the Franciscan holy city. You will also visit the Hermitage today. (B, L)

September 24:

On this day, you will have a full day excursion to Fonte Colombo and Greccio. FonteColombo is the place where, St. Francis, during a stay of meditation lasting forty days in 1223, received confirmation of the Franciscan Order by Jesus, which he dictated to Brother Leone. The location, on the side of a hill immersed in the woods, is beautiful and charming. Greccio is where St. Francis, recalling a visit he had made years before to Bethlehem, resolved to create the manger he had seen there. The ideal spot was a cave in nearby Greccio. He would find a baby, hay upon which to lay him, an ox and an ass to stand beside the manger. Word went out to the people of the town. At the appointed time they arrived carrying torches and candles. One of the friars began celebrating Mass while Francis himself gave the sermon. (B, L)

September 25:

Free day to enjoy Assisi at your leisure (B)

September 26:

A full day in La Verna, a religious retreat and contemplation point for Saint Francis; it was also the location where he received the Stigmata. La Verna is a mountain complex for the Franciscans to break away from the fast-pace material world of the city. The landscape is stunning with the complex set on a cliff overlooking a valley. La Verna is made up of many small chapels and a large church; some of the Franciscan friars live there permanently while other orders of the Franciscans come to spend time in peace. (B, L)

September 27:

After breakfast today we will board our motorcoach and travel back to Rome. Upon arrival we will check into our guesthouse and enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure. (B, D)

September 28:

Today you will have a full day doing the Christian Rome tour. Sights include—St. Paul’s Basilica Outside the Wall, St. John Lateran and St. Mary Major. (B)

September 29:

On this day, you will enjoy a tour of the Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapel and St. Peter’s Basilica. (B, D)

September 30:

Morning or early afternoon transfer to the airport for the departure back to the United States.
