

Almighty, eternal, just and merciful God, give us the ability to act in accordance with our knowledge of your will and to desire always what pleases you.

#### The purpose of ongoing formation:

# Strengthen the vocation and sense of belonging of the professed members and help the newly professed to solidify their commitment and integrate into the fraternity.

# Respond to the church's call to mission as laity in the world by responding to the teachings of Jesus;

# Give **new dimension to the lay vocation** as part of the Franciscan family by following the spirituality of Saint Francis and by developing a deep knowledge of the Gospel, the Rule and Constitutions and the writings of Saint Francis and Saint Clare.

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#### The agents of formation:

As above, but consider the following:


- How do you as an individual member provide ongoing formation for yourself? Do you keep up with the latest information from the Church and from Franciscan Sources?
- The local fraternity; the council; the formation director and the team should work together with the Spiritual Assistant to plan our the ongoing formation program. Topics should relate.
- Hight levels: Our region has many opportunities—Cluster events, Convivenza, Chapter, yearly retreat. The national fraternity has many resources on their website. (See link at end of this document.)

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### There are four aspects to ongoing formation


- Teaching about the Catholic Church

- Prayer (Franciscan prayer life; praying the Scriptures)




There are four aspects to ongoing formation

Teaching about the Catholic Church


- +Application of the word of God to daily life: "Gospel to life and life to the Gospel."
- +Our Catholic faith and our role in the Church
- + Deepening of the sacramental aspect of life
- +How we apply our faith to our daily life in all dimensions
- + Deepening of the study of Church documents Catholic social teaching
- + Ecclesiology
- + Magisterium of the Catholic Church
- + Commitment of the laity: the mission of the laity in the Church.
- +Church and ecumenism: ecumenical and interreligious dialogue
- +Annual liturgical celebrations



- Franciscan topics (our documents; writings of Francis and Clare; writings by Franciscan authors)
- +Deepening of the knowledge of the Franciscan Sources (Writings of Saint Francis and Sant Clare, biographies and other Franciscan authors);
- + Saint Clare of Assisi: the feminine side of Franciscan spirituality;

#### **Suggested Formats**

- Short presentations followed by small group or partner sharing (Formation Fridays are good for this.)—Rotate presenters
- Collective Wisdom conversations on topics familiar to the fraternity (some prior preparation)
- Large group sharing after a talk or video
- Action items that might arise personally or for the fraternity link it to an article of the Rule or Constitutions whenever possible
- Choose a Franciscan Book that lends itself to discussion of individual chapters
- Discussions on Scripture or on the Rule

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#### Give plenty of time for discussion

- +Partners
- +Small groups
- +Large group

Be sure that the facilitator of discussions has a clear picture of what the goal of the discussion is. She or he should always lead the topic back to the desired focus.

Random chatting is good for the social time, but not for ongoing formation.
